The charter recognises and accepts the diversity of the Wairarapa community and shall abide by the principles of the Treaty of Waitangi.

Part One

We, the undersigned hereby:

- 1.1 recognise and accept that violence in all forms is not acceptable and will not be tolerated in our community
- 1.2 recognise and accept that my organisation and I have a major interest in and can make a positive contribution in eliminating violence
- 1.3 recognise and accept that to achieve this goal, my organisation and I must work co-operatively and collaboratively with all the co-signatories of this charter and other organisations
- 1.4 recognise and accept in order to achieve this goal, we must have vision and courage and must continually assess all agreed processes

Having acknowledged the above principles my organisation and I commit ourselves to the following goal. **Eliminate All Forms Of Violence From The Wairarapa**

Part Two

To achieve this goal, within our organisation we shall:

- 2.1 align and incorporate this goal into our Strategic and Annual Plans
- 2.2 contribute and participate effectively at the levels which are appropriate and agreed
- 2.3 provide leadership and positive role models to drive this project
- 2.4 abide by the principles and spirit of this charter
- 2.5 work in partnership between all groups and all people in a manner that encourages unity within our diverse community

In our service delivery, we shall:

- 2.6 work towards changing individual and community attitudes to violence
- 2.7 encourage individuals to take personal responsibility for all their actions
- 2.8 encourage the community to take joint responsibility for the actions of its people
- 2.9 encourage positive activities within the community
- 2.10 provide an agreed mandatory response to all reported acts of violence
- 2.11 support all co-signatories and other organisations to deliver their respective service
- 2.12 where appropriate, share and facilitate the sharing of information with co-signatories and other organisations

I therefore on behalf of my organisation affirm our commitment and collective aim to achieve defined levels of service and our goal to: **Eliminate All Forms Of Violence From The Wairarapa**
